Guidelines

The requirements according to § 8 BAföG are met by all Germans and, as a rule, by foreign students in Germany ("Bildungsinländer") as well as individuals who are entitled to permanent residence in Germany (e.g. EU citizens).

A person is considered to be "Bildungsinländer" (a foreign student in Germany) if he or she is accepted to one German universities in Germany (but also to German universities abroad).

Foreign students as "BildungsinländerInnen" (who acquire education in Germany) are funded according to the guidelines of the BMBF (BAföG).
